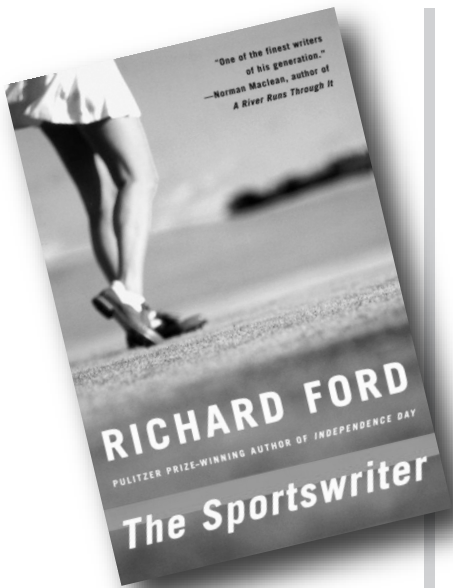

The Sportswriter, set in the suburbs of New Jersey, is the first of three novels that center on the character of Frank Bascombe. *The Globe and Mail* of Toronto writes that "Ford captures the intricacies of human beings better than just about any other writer alive....
